**RE: CONFIRMATION OF NETBALL NEW ZEALAND AND NETBALL MAINLAND ZONE  
AFFILIATION/MEMBERSHIP FEES FOR 2019**

The purpose of player affiliation/membership fees is to support the growth, development and delivery of Netball at all levels of the game and to assist with ensuring the financial stability of Netball across the Netball Mainland Zone (NM) and New Zealand as a whole.

To reflect the structure of the Junior Netball Programme; Year 1 & 2, Year 3 & 4 and Year 5 & 6 category fees will be based/collected on an individual basis, as many players in these age groups will not participate in these programmes in a traditional 'team' format.

All other fees categories are collected on a per team basis.

Recreational/social fees are set at one fee irrespective of the duration of the competition.

At the 16 October 2018 Netball Mainland Board meeting, the Board resolved that affiliation (membership) fees payable by players, via their Centres, to the Zone for 2019 are as follows;

The 2019 Netball Mainland Zone fees above represent; no increase for Years 1 to 4 and Recreational, and a CPI increase of 1.5% (rounded down) for all other categories, compared to 2018.

The NNZ and NM Zone fees will both be collected via single itemised invoice in April/May 2019, the Zone will then forward the NNZ fees portion to them.
