The annual Marriott's Hadlee Sports Awards were held recently at the Wigram Air Force Museum, showcasing the best of sport in Canterbury and the West Coast regions. There were 125 nominations across 30 sporting codes representing the 2014 calendar year.

Netball was nominated across 8 categories, with Keshia Grant and Polly Hazeldine finalists in their categories. Although both Polly and Keshia excelled in 2014, they were unfortunate to miss out on the top honours on the night. Amanda Nottingham was also recognized for her contribution to the sport with a 'Lifetime Achievement Award'.

NM have also had seven coaches who have taken the next step and have applied to be part of Netball New Zealand's Performance Coach Award, having gone through the process of being endorsed from the centres and an interview with Leigh Gibbs, Netball Mainland's Performance Manager. **Congratulations to Nicole Lloyd** who has been the first coach from Netball Mainland Zone to be accepted into the award for 2015 the rest are now waiting to hear from Netball New Zealand on their acceptance.

Nelson Netball Centre also run a number of Netball New Zealand Modules around the Super Club finals with Game Analysis being run on the Super club semi-final with 11 coaches able to see the difference between just watching a game and analysing a game there were some very intense conversations had by all. 30 coaches in all attended the 4 different Modules run over the weekend.

Coach Observation of the Tactix home games has also seen "**Straight from the Horse's Mouth**" run alongside each of these, Leigh Gibbs works with a group of coaches who meet at Spectators Restaurant and Bar (Addington Raceway) for a few nibbles before the game then Tactix assistant coach Maryanne Delaney-Hoshek comes to speak to the group. The coaches have tasks to complete during the game with discussion and then they meet in the Tuck Shop at Horncastle Arena after the game to discuss what they have seen. Coach's feedback so far has been that this is an awesome opportunity.

"Apprentice Coach for the Day" has run again around all Tactix's home games with one coach per game getting to be a 'fly on the wall' and see what it is like behind the scene on game day, Performance Coach Award participants are eligible to apply.

REMINDER NM AND NNZ REQUIREMENTS

Many Centres have had, or are about to have, your AGM - please remember to send a copy of your Annual Report including Audited Financial Statements for the last financial year to Netball New Zealand (Jennie Wylie) and Netball Mainland Zone (Brigit Hearn) within one month of holding your Centre AGM, and send to the Incorporated Societies office for them to download on their website. Many thanks.

Your latest Constitution (post 2012 formation of Zones) should be visible on your website and uploaded onto the Incorporated Societies website. A recent audit revealed that only one of our 18 Centres were compliant.

REMINDER FOR CENTRES ON INCORPORATED SOCIETIES REQUIREMENTS

It is important a Centre remains up to date with its legal requirements to maintain incorporated society status. A Centre is only an official legal entity if it remains registered. If a Centre does not meet the compulsory requirements, they have the potential to be struck off the incorporated society register.

As a reminder to all Centres to remain incorporated, there is a compulsory requirement of uploading an Annual Financial Statement. The financial statement should be filed with the Registrar when financial statements have been approved at the Annual General Meeting (AGM). The deadline for filing is the end of the month after the AGM. For example, if the AGM month is January, the financial statements are due to be filed before 28 February.

Failure to file a Financial Return one month post your AGM gives the Registrar the potential to strike your Centre (become struck off) from the Registrar.

There is also a requirement to upload a copy of your Centre's constitution. If your Centre has not updated its constitution following the Netball restructure in 2012, your constitution is now out of date. All Centre constitutions should have been updated after 2012.

In line with the Whole of Netball Plan, we want to develop a strong and sustainable delivery system for Netball and ensuring all organisations are meeting incorporated society requirements is an important part of this.
