COACHING

STRONGER TOGETHER ROADSHOW

During August, Sue Hawkins and Tammy Mehrtens hit the road and travelled to 5 of Netball Mainland's Centres to offer players one on one coaching with their shooting technique and to offer coaching tips and ideas around creating strong defensive pressure. Throughout the month Sue worked with almost 60 young shooters and over 100 coaches in South Canterbury, Christchurch, North Canterbury, Hurunui, Blenheim and Nelson.



It is fantastic to see so many coaches around our Zone who are passionate about developing their knowledge and taking opportunities to learn. Netball Mainland are fortunate to have a Franchise Coach who is enthusiastic about getting out into the community and sharing coaching tools. Sue's expertise was gratefully received by the coaches in attendance and all feedback about the sessions from both players and coaches has been extremely positive.

Later this month Sue will be running a final session which will be filmed so that coaches who attended the workshops have access to this to use in their own time. The idea is for coaches to take snippets of what Sue has delivered and adapt and mould it into something that is appropriate for the stage and age of their players.

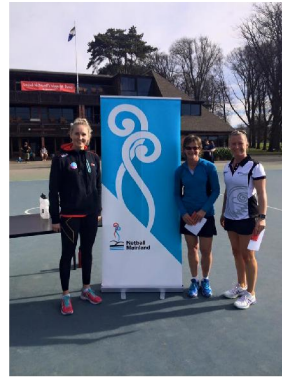
