Hello from the team here at Netball Mainland.

You may have seen the recent articles in magazines, Press and TV regarding EasiYo Tactix player Mwai Kumwenda and her desire to help the people in her homeland of Malawi. Mwai particularly wants to help the woman and children of her village by getting them involved in sport. Mwai is raising funds to build a netball court and buy sporting equipment for the children in her village so that she can run coaching sessions with the children.

"A lot of the girls get married very young, like at 14. If they saw me and see a Malawian girl can come here and do well, that would be great," Mwai says.

As well as raising money for equipment, Mwai's friends and family at the EasiYo Tactix have collected clothes, furniture, toys and books for the families in Mwai's village and are arranging for this to be shipped to Malawi. Mwai will then distribute these when she returns to home after representing Malawi at the Commonwealth Games.

Netball New Zealand in partnership with Zones and Sport New Zealand is excited to announce the selection of eight coaches into the inaugural "Sport New Zealand Performance Coach Advance Programme."

Performance Coach Advance is a new coach development programme designed to improve the overall quality and understanding of Performance Coaching within New Zealand and promotes the importance of coaching in the pre-elite performance area. It is designed to be delivered alongside the "Pathway to Podium Programme" through a network of regional coach development Centres led by Regional Programme Leaders appointed by Sport New Zealand.

The programme is based upon Lynn's Coach Learning Model with a mix of learning mediums used to maximize impact. Coaches will be in the programme for a year and will attend a series of seminars, have access to mentoring support and be part of small group of coaches from across a variety of sports.

JUNIOR NETBALL

16 Centres from across our Zone are now running NNZ's Year 1&2 Junior Netball Programme, with amazing success. Amongst these 16 Centres, five have also chosen to run the Year 3 & 4 programme this year. Feedback received to date has been fantastic not only from a programme perspective, but also from a delivery perspective.

More than 1000 children are benefitting from this new programme in its first year of roll-out \odot what a great achievement for us as a Zone!!
