2014 NETBALL NEW ZEALAND COUNCIL AND AGM SUMMARY

A more detailed summary has been previously circulated by email to all Centre Administrators and Presidents re NNZ AGM held in Hamilton on Saturday 22 February 2014.

Key Points:

- Debbie Hodges Netball South, was elected to the Netball New Zealand Board to replace out-going Board member Carole Maddix.
- NNZ Board Chair, Raewyn Lovett presented the 2013 NNZ Annual Report (including financial statements) which can be viewed on the NNZ website.
- NNZ declared a 2013 Group Surplus of \$1.049 million.
- NNZ budgeting for Group Surplus of \$447k in 2014.

ANZ CHAMPIONSHIP 2014 UP DATE



Round 1 of the ANZC has again lived up to expectations of being the toughest competition in world netball. After an encouraging pre-season build up including a win in Timaru against neighbours Steel and some good results coming out of the "Summer Shoot Out" in Melbourne, the EasiYo Tactix had all squad members excited and ready for the first ANZC game against Magic at home in the CBS Arena. Competition for the seven places on court is keen and coaches are pleased with how trainings have been progressing.

The EasiYo Tactix team was looking forward to continuing their good pre-season form so were all very disappointed with their performance and loss 70 – 46 against the Magic in front of a supportive home crowd last Saturday. They will be working hard to turn it around for our game against Swifts this coming Sunday 09 March (7.20 p.m.) at CBS Arena.

11 May Game against Pulse in Nelson

We are delighted that our Round 11 ANZ Championship match against the Haier Pulse will remain in Nelson.

The original venue for the game, the Trafalgar Centre, was closed in mid-December 2013 and Nelson's Saxton Stadium has been announced as the replacement venue for the match in May.

Since the announcement of the closing of the Trafalgar Centre, we have been working with the Nelson City Council to find an alternative venue and ensure compliance with SKY Television broadcasting and ANZ Championship hosting standards are met.

We are very grateful for the support of the Nelson City Council, Sport Tasman and the Nelson Netball Centre to ensure the game remained in Nelson and look forward to playing before a capacity crowd on 11 May 2014.

The ANZ Championship match between the EasiYo Tactix and Haier Pulse will start at 7.20 pm on Sunday May 11 and is preceded by the College Netball competition's first semi-final between the winners of the Upper North Island and South Island.



Maori Television has confirmed a deal with SKY to screen the 2014 ANZ Championship free-to-air on the Te Reo Channel from March 4.

In a first for New Zealand television, the Maori language channel will screen delayed coverage of one game from each round of the 17-week competition, including the finals, on Tuesday nights at 8.30pm.

Ex-Silver Fern Jenny-May Coffin and former Maori Television sports reporter Taroi Black will provide commentary in 100 per cent te reo Maori.

Talent Spotters are asked to keep an eye out for new talented young players between 15 – 18 years of age in their local Centres and give the names of these players to the Netball Mainland (NM) Selector aligned to their Centre.

The NM Selectors will track their performances as well as the current Emerging Talent Squad players throughout the season at various school and centre competitions and tournaments.

The NM Selectors role is to identify talented players to invite into the 2014 – 2015 ET and Train On Squads. Invitations will be sent out to the players in October.

National Age Group Championships

If they haven't already, Centres will be making decisions in the next few weeks about the make-up of their U19 and U17 teams for the annual national age groups championships being held at the Dunedin Netball Centre and Netball North Harbour in July.

- U23 (Zone) and U19 July 7 10 in Dunedin
- U17 July 14 17 in North Harbour

Centres are asked to confirm to Leigh Gibbs whether they will be entering the championships as a 'single Centre' entry or a 'cluster Centre' (more than one Centre) entry by Friday 28 March.
