Organisation for the Super Club competition as discussed at the Zone Forum is progressing. A draft draw has been established and circulated amongst some Centre representatives for a 'first' look.

Once their feedback has been received it will then go out to all Centres for their feedback. It is hoped to have the final draw and competition rules confirmed by the end of October so venues can be booked and Centres can plan their club's involvement.
