#### **Emerging Talent Squad**

Players have to commit to the full programme and respond to NM's Performance Manager Leigh Gibbs by 10 October. Once players have been confirmed Centres and schools will be notified of the final list.

Following LFNC, invitations will be sent to identified players for the Train Ons and Accelerant Squads. Players will be interviewed during October before confirming their selection into the respective squads.

Selections for these squads will be completed after the NZSS Championships. As with the players, umpires will be invited into the respective squads in order to consider their involvement.

#### LION FOUNDATION NETBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS

A busy final few weeks of preparation lies ahead for the Christchurch Netball Centre team preparing for the upcoming Lion Foundation National Championships.

Fourteen teams from all over New Zealand have entered the Championships and been split into four pools; two pools with four teams and two pools with three teams to play in a round robin format. The Championship then moves into play-off brackets - the top eight teams and the bottom six teams.

The top eight will play-off through quarter-final, semi-final and final classification games.

Pool A features defending champions Dunedin, Counties Manukau, Eastern Waikato and Kapi Mana. Pool B has Hamilton, Waitakere and Hutt Valley. Pool C has Christchurch, Wellington and Bay of Plenty, while Pool D has Auckland, North Harbour, Thames Valley and Taranaki.
