### A NOTE FROM THE COACH

#### **Planning**

Planning is an integral part of being a coach. It is an exciting time- shaping your overall vision and being able to drive it.

It is best to get "buy in" to a vision so that it is a shared vision for a season with you, your staff and your players. You can do this with the entire group at the start of the season.

When planning content, I always focus on the following things:



- 1. What does winning performance look like?
- 2. Where are we now? And what are the performance gaps between these 2 things.
- 3. What will it take to get there? (Cornerstone priorities, big rocks, who are the critical people in the tight team? How will you measure your performance?, what are the risks?, competition plan).

With your staff, it is important that you work out a vision of how you would like to operate as a group first and foremost. This can shape the way that your group functions and get everyone working effectively together. Role clarity is the most important thing when setting the team up. Make sure you are very clear on this.

To keep things fresh each year- I always use a theme to spice things up. You can work your theme into everything you do and it creates a real fun factor.
