COACH DEVELOPMENT

With the netball season looming, our Netball Mainland coach developers have been busy planning, scheduling and facilitating the NNZ coaching modules. The service we provide to our netball coaching community is a priority, as this will enable coaches to be confident and effective in what they do. In order to do this, our Netball Mainland coach developers attend many developmental opportunities, to grow and enhance their skills as facilitators. What better way to do this than by attending the first Netball Mainland coach developer forum for the year, on 24 March 2018, at the High Performance New Zealand centre, in Christchurch. It was an exciting forum, as for the first time Netball Mainland collaborated with another Regional Sport Organisation (RSO), Canterbury Tennis. We were privileged to have Adam Gard'ner from Canterbury Tennis co-present in the facilitation of our team culture, as well as providing support and guidance to our coach developers throughout the day. We look forward to future collaborations with other RSOs, as this will enable our coach developers to provide a quality service to our netball coaching community.

If you want to better your skills as a coach and need help with the "how to", then connect with your relevant netball centre to ascertain what NNZ coaching module would be most suitable for your level. If attending a NNZ coaching module appears daunting and you would like to attend something less formal. Once again, contact a netball development officer and/or coach co-ordinator at your nearest netball centre to discuss what informal modules are on offer. Although informal modules can provide an alternative learning environment, we encourage all to attend the NNZ coaching modules to support your coach development. NNZ has invested in well-researched learning programmes for all coaches at varying levels. The coaching modules recognises the different ages and stages of a player and responds to their needs as they change throughout life. Not only do the modules guide and support coaches to help develop a player's technical and tactical abilities. Most importantly, it takes a holistic view to develop the whole person's physical, cognitive, social and spiritual needs. When we do this, it provides a positive sporting experience which inspires on-going participation.



As our Silvermoon Tactix and Beko girls are getting ready for their first hit out on the court. So too are the coaches and supporting staff. NETBALLSMART

Did you know that a netballer can do 60-jumps and resultant landings in a 60-min game of Netball? Female athletes undergo major body changes during the adolescent growth spurt which changes the way they land and absorb forces, from what was once a safe biomechanic in their childhood, to a high-risk one. The NetballSmart program will help enforce safe landing strategies, equip them with the strength required to reduce their injury risk and warm their mind and body up for the game of Netball.

Come along to a NetballSmart Landing Skill Development workshop and learn techniques to include effective jump and land activities into your training sessions.

A NOTE FROM THE COACH

Learning - My favourite thing!

I am a bit of a curious person and my favourite question is why? There is no better question in my eyes.

This question informs my programme, my staff and will ultimately help me to be a better coach to my players.

















I have done so much professional development over the years and I believe that hand in hand with great coaching opportunities has helped me learn and grow. I believe you can't have one without the other.

I gather lots of ideas and information and then I filter the things I like. I don't use everything that I learn straight away as I believe you have to make it your own. I keep all my notes etc and go back through them regularly picking up pearls of info.

Some of the best knowledge you can get comes from other coaches. I have been lucky enough to work with some fantastic netball coaches as well as mix with coaches from other sports who are in similar positions to me.

I am currently doing a course called Coach Accelerator which is run by High Performance Sport New Zealand which is fantastic as you get to chat to other coaches in a variety of other sports. I am really lucky as we have 14 coaches in our intake from a huge variety of other team and individual sports. We have 3 camps a year and they range from doing horse whispering to learning about how to look after ourselves to clearing out rooms with the armed offenders with the Police. Each camp everyone brings a case study of something that is happening within our sport at present that the others may be able to help with and I think this is where the biggest learning happens.

I would recommend trying to set up your own network of coaches around you to get knowledge from, assist you and so on. Going into each other's environments is a great idea and watching each other coach. It is also great going to other sports to see how they do things. Crusaders and Canterbury Rugby have been fantastic in assisting us to be better at things and here at the Apollo Centre we work alongside some of the best coaches in the business so it is great be able to collaborate with them.

I have missed out on a lot of jobs on my journey but I really believe that everything happens for a reason. Missing out has made me a better coach as I always sought feedback to be better for next time.

After I made a complete stuff up of an interview a couple of years ago I spent a lot of time re-doing my CV, practising interviews and presenting myself.

I always have something on the go that I am wanting to improve.
